SB 207

Authorizes Oregon Government Ethics Commission to proceed on own motion to review and investigate, if commission has reason to believe that public body conducted meetings in executive session that were not in compliance with laws authorizing executive sessions.

SB 877

Restores staggering of terms of county commissioners in certain circumstances.

HB 2031 A

Renames "board of property tax appeals" to "property value appeals board."

HB 2159

Alters supplemental reporting requirements required to be filed by State Treasurer and specified employees in office of State Treasurer to be based on best practices for state investment funds and to be comparable in scope to disclosure required for investment advisers under federal law, including under Rule 204A-1 and Investment Advisers Act of 1940.

HB 2266

Modifies membership of State Interoperability Executive Council.

HB 2267

Removes requirement that term of office for voting member of Oregon Geographic Information Council begins on January 1.

SB 203

Transfers Director of Affirmative Action from office of Governor to Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

HB 2112 A

Updates definitions and terminology used in public records law pertaining to records retention.
