Work Session

SJR 33

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to enumerate examples of rights, the denial or abridgement of which would violate existing constitutional guarantee of equality of rights.

SB 27

Requires Secretary of State to conduct study and analyze provisions of Oregon Constitution, Oregon Revised Statutes and Oregon Administrative Rules relating to voter access.

SB 1079

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study hospital licensing requirements.

SB 192 A

Requires pharmacy benefit managers to annually report to Department of Consumer and Business Services information about certain rebates, fees, price protection payments and other payments received from prescription drug manufacturers.

SB 556

Prohibits public bodies from seizing certain benefits and resources intended for persons in custody of Department of Human Services.

SB 106

Requires Department of Human Services to study disposition rates of child abuse investigations.

SB 233

Increases salaries of state court judges.
