## Human Trafficking

### Sex Trafficking

Sex trafficking is the crime of using force, fraud, or coercion to induce another individual to sell sex, or when a minor under the age of 18 is encouraged or persuaded to perform and/or sell sex.

### Labor Trafficking

Labor trafficking is the crime of using force, fraud, or coercion to induce another individual to work or provide services.
