Who we help

- **Probation** Individuals on supervision in the community under the jurisdiction of the court.
- **Transitional Leave** Those released from prison to community supervision 30-120 days early. Individuals remain under DOC jurisdiction until their earliest projected release date.
- Local Control Those serving an in-custody sentence of 12 months or less for a new crime or revocation of community supervision. Sentences are typically served at a county facility.
- **Parole/Post-Prison Supervision** Individuals on supervision in the community under the jurisdiction of the Parole Board or the local supervisory authority of a Parole and Probation Officer (PO).




