SUMMARY

Requires Oregon State University Extension Service and College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State University to study fate and transport of perflouroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in biosolids applied to agricultural fields. Directs extension service and college to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to agriculture not later than September 15, 2025.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a study concerning PFAS in biosolids applied to land; and pre-

3 scribing an effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon State University Extension Service and 5the College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State University shall 6 conduct a study of the fate and transport of perflouroalkyl and 7 polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in biosolids that are applied 8 to agricultural fields across this state. In conducting the study under 9 this section, the extension service and the college shall collaborate 10 11 with the Department of Environmental Quality and Oregon wastewater service providers to: 12

(a) Identify PFAS concentrations in biosolids produced by selected
 wastewater treatment facilities in this state;

(b) Compare the PFAS concentrations identified under paragraph
 (a) of this subsection to PFAS concentrations in the selected agricul tural fields where biosolids have been applied as a soil amendment;

18 (c) Examine the potential for PFAS to leach into ground water; and NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type. 1 (d) Examine PFAS uptake in representative crops from various 2 ecosystems in this state.

3 (2) The extension service and college shall submit a report in the
4 manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the
5 Legislative Assembly related to agriculture no later than September
6 15, 2025.

7 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-8 ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating 9 Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-10 eral Fund, \$500,000 for distribution to Oregon State University to carry 11 out the study under section 1 of this 2023 Act.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date
 on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.
