
Oregon's Juvenile Justice System (to scale)


Oregon's Juvenile Justice System Law enforcement referral to **Adjudicated in County probation** juvenile court juvenile court If unsuccessful or need more services Waiver hearing for Judge keeps case in **OYA** Commitment most serious crimes* juvenile court **OYA** Probation **OYA Close Custody** Judge waives to adult court **OYA** Parole Guilty – offense DOC **Charged in** committed before (community adult court age 18; sentenced corrections or facility) before age 20

*Waiver hearings only happen if requested by prosecutor
