Establishes School Safety Construction Fund in State Treasury. Establishes requirements for Fund and allowable uses for school district grants. Takes effect on the 91st day after sine die.

BACKGROUND:

Under current law, the Oregon School Capital Improvement Matching Program (OSCIM) provides matching grants to districts that pass a local general obligation bond. House Bill 2257 establishes a new fund for construction projects related to school safety.
