Subject: Legislative Concepts for Introduction

1. LC 3654 (dated 1/9/2023): Relating to collective bargaining over matters concerning on-the-job safety.

Introduction: At the request of AFSCME

Summary: Modifies definition of “employment relations” for purposes of collective bargaining to include safety issues and staffing levels that have significant impact on on-the-job safety of employees.

2. LC 1486 (dated 10/25/2022): Relating to chiropractic physicians.

Introduction: At the request of Oregon Chiropractic Association

Summary: Removes limits on duration of medical service and number of visits and certain areas of practice for chiropractic physicians serving as attending physicians in workers’ compensation claims.
