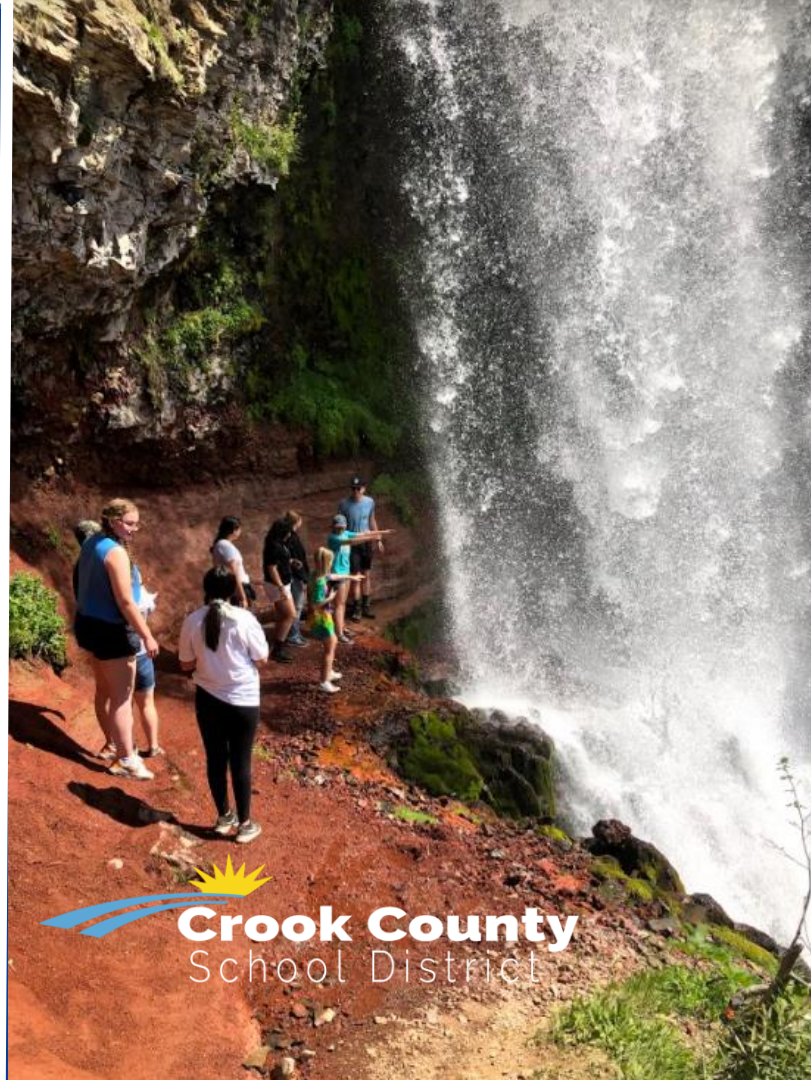

- **45** Incoming Freshman earn at least .5 credits

SUMMER BLAST STEM CAMP

- 537 elementary students
- 412 students per/day
