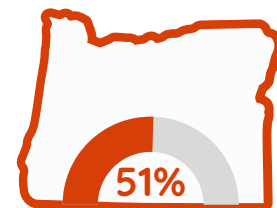
We accomplish this by:

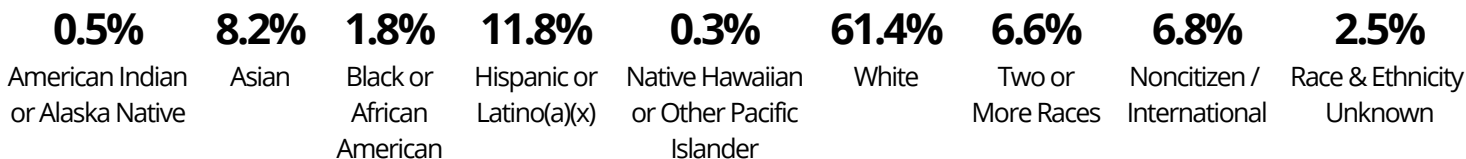


35,239 students enrolled

Resident Students[†]

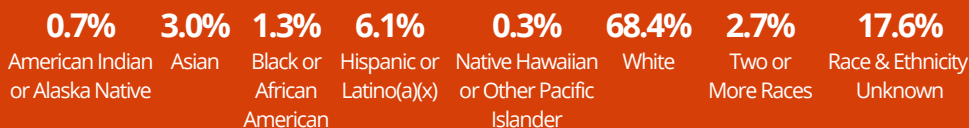

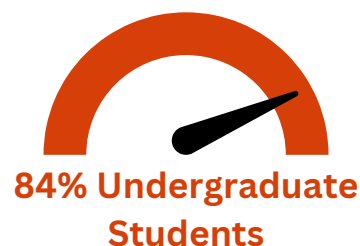

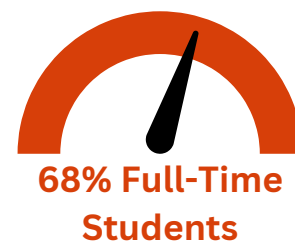

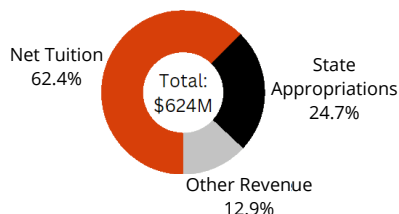


84% Undergraduate Students

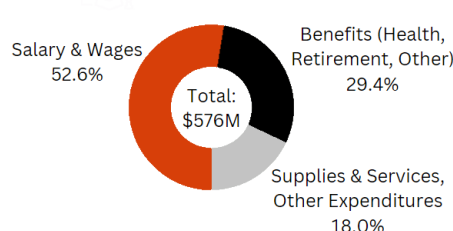


68% Full-Time Students
