On February 1st, the Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommended approval of the submission of a federal grant application from the Department of Transportation to the U.S. Department of Transportation - Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity grant program - in the amount of \$20 million for additional improvements to Oregon 99 in Phoenix, Oregon.

If successful, the grant will fund a second phase of an improvement project already underway. The grant would allow for improvements to sidewalks and crosswalks that enhance pedestrian safety, as well as bike lanes, drainage, widening, and a two way left turn lane. Matching funds of \$4 million would come from State Highway Fund dollars set aside as matching funds. No additional agency positions are assumed to be necessary if the grant is awarded.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends approval.
