**Subject:** Legislative Concepts for Introduction

**1. LC 3935 (dated 2/7/2023): Relating to services provided by qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities**

**Introduction:** At the request of the League of Oregon Cities

**Summary:** Permits public agency to establish specifications for cleaning and security services that public agency procures from qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities. Allows public agency to inspect and evaluate cleaning and security services provided and to terminate agreement with qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities that provides cleaning or security services that do not meet public agency's specifications.

**2. LC 4241 (dated 2/2/2023): Relating to Leave**

**Introduction:** At the request of Rep. Paul Holvey

**Summary:** Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues related to family leave. Directs bureau to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to business and labor not later than September 15, 2024.
