WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon State University Extension Service to collaborate with Department of Education (ODE) to identify and collect student data relevant to outdoor school programs.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Outdoor School is a multi-day residential program in outdoor settings for Oregon fifth and sixth graders. Established under the provisions of Senate Bill 439 (2015) and Measure 99 (2016), the program uses lottery funds to provide students with outdoor-based educational experiences supported by the Oregon State University Extension Service.

House Bill 3037 requires the OSU Extension Service to collaborate with ODE on outdoor school data collection.
