

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 5544

2021-23 Capital Construction

SB 5544 adjusts six-year capital construction expenditure limitation established in the 2021-23 biennium for the planning, design, and construction of projects with costs over \$1 million. Specifically, the bill, as amended:

- Increases Federal Funds capital construction expenditure limitation by \$20.2 million in the Oregon Military Department for construction of barracks facilities at the former Camp Umatilla which is now known as the Rees Training Center.
- Reduces Other Funds capital construction expenditure limitation by \$20 million in the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for a new residence hall at Oregon Institute of Technology. The university wants to construct a smaller building.
- Modifies Other Funds capital construction expenditure limitation for the Department of Education for Oregon School for the Deaf projects. Three projects are being combined into a single ADA Restrooms, Fire Alarm System Replacement and Window Upgrades project. There is no change to the total expenditure limitation.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 5544 be amended by the –1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
