Dear Chair Taylor & Vice-Chair Bonham,

Thank you for allowing me to testify yesterday on the Oregon Employment Department's legislative concept in Senate Bill 913. I appreciated your insightful questions and comments and your support for the bill. This letter serves to respond to the question I was unable to answer during my testimony.

What is the impact to the Paid Leave Oregon Trust Fund if the maximum wage amount was changed from \$132,900 to the current social security wage base index (\$160,200)?

The below table shows employees total taxable wages for 2021 using Unemployment Insurance information. The first column is the contributions that would have been paid with the current statutory maximum wage amount of \$132,900 broken out by the large employer and employee ratio. The second column indicates contributions that would have been paid if the maximum wage amount was tied to the 2023 social security wage base index amount of \$160,200. The third column shows the increase to the Paid Leave Oregon Trust Fund if the maximum wage amount was raised.
