WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Defines “third-party logistics provider,” and “wholesale distributor drug outlet” in Oregon Law (ORS 689.005).
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

REVENUE: No revenue impact

FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Federal Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) includes provisions designed to strengthen the integrity of the pharmaceutical distribution supply chain, including licensure of prescription drug wholesale distributors and third-party logistics providers.

Senate Bill 970 updates Oregon Law (ORS 689.005) so that statutory definitions are identical with federal law.
