Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health and Science University, in consultation with Oregon Department of Administrative Services and Department of Revenue, to conduct study to determine how best to revise repayment method for individuals who receive scholarship from Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative, but who do not fulfill required service agreement.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services, Department of Revenue, Oregon Health Sciences University

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the House Committee on Higher Education.

The measure requires the Oregon Health and Science University to study a better repayment process for individuals who receive a scholarship for Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative and do not fulfill the requirements of the program. The measure allows OHSU to consult with the Department of Administrative Services and the Department of Revenue. OHSU’s findings must be delivered in a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Higher Education.
