WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to study how to improve processes for transferring credit earned outside the United States to high schools in Oregon. Establishes reporting requirements.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, each school district maintains its own system for recording students' course completion data. When students transfer from one school or district to another, they may face challenges if the school or district they move to does not accept the course information from their prior school or district. This process is more complex for students who arrive in Oregon from other countries, who may or may not have written transcripts, and whose transcripts may potentially be written in languages other than English.

Senate Bill 940 requires the Oregon Department of Education to study the issue of foreign school records and issue a report.
