WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs the Department of Transportation to disclose personal information to mass transit districts established under ORS Chapter 267 for the purpose of investigating and enforcing ordinances of the mass transit district.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division (DMV) of the Oregon Department of Transportation is the agency responsible for licensing individuals to operate motor vehicles in Oregon, and also for issuing identification cards for persons who are not drivers but who wish to have a state-issued identification card. ORS 802.179 outlines when, and to whom, DMV is to disclose personal information from its motor vehicle records for use on matters ranging from collections related to court proceedings, toll collection, or public safety operations.

House Bill 3170 directs DMV to disclose personal information to mass transit districts for purposes of investigating and enforcing ordinances of the mass transit district.
