

HB 3121 -1 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to study methods to make public higher education affordable for Oregonians. Requires HECC to submit report and possible recommendations to Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Provisions of amendment
- Competing costs of food, housing, tuition, and textbooks
- Increase in cost of textbooks relative to inflation

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Appropriates \$5,200,000 General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of carrying out Oregon's Open Educational Resources Program. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.
