WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates money to Oregon Business Development Department to distribute to areas with high poverty to develop poverty reduction plans. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3466 appropriates 2.775 million dollars to areas of Oregon with census tracts with a federal poverty rate above 23 percent to develop local poverty reduction plans and work with the Oregon Business Development Department to refine that plan.
