Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for costs related to increasing statewide capacity of licensed residential facilities serving individuals with substance use disorders or mental health concerns.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Capital Construction, Counties, Cities, Oregon Health Authority

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates an unspecified amount from the General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority for costs related to increasing statewide capacity of licensed substance use disorder and mental health residential facilities.
