- Severe shortage of behavioral health practitioners
- US Surgeon General advisory on youth mental health crisis
- February 2023: CDC <u>Youth Risk Behavior Study</u>
  - -42% of high school students report ...
  - 57% of female students...
  - -Nearly 1 in 3 female high school students ...
