Measure Description:

Provides procedure whereby an elected judge may challenge a party, attorney, law firm, district attorney's office, defense consortium, or public defender's office that files a motion or a series of motions against the elected judge that effectively denies the judge assignment to criminal or juvenile delinquency docket within the judge's judicial district.
