WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs the Department of Human Services to ensure adults who receive developmental disability services are provided the supports that they need to live in homes that they own or rent and with the support of roommates that they choose.

BACKGROUND:

<u>The Office of Developmental Disability Services</u> (ODDS)offers services to adults ranging from supports to assist an individual to live in their own home or with family or friends, to 24-hour comprehensive services. Services offered have specific eligibility standards and are offered through local <u>Community Developmental Disabilities Programs</u> (<u>CDDP</u>).

Senate Bill 759 directs the Department of Human Services to ensure adults who receive developmental disability services are provided the supports that they need to live in homes that they own or rent and with the support of roommates that they choose.
