Measure Description:

Removes cap on amounts distributed from State School Fund to school districts for students eligible for special education as children with disabilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Education, School Districts

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the House Committee on Revenue.

House Bill 2895 eliminates the cap on amounts distributed from the State School Fund to school districts for students eligible for special education as children with disabilities. The measure provides additional weight for students experiencing homelessness and directs the Oregon Department of Education to collect specified information related to homeless students. The measure takes effect on July 1, 2023.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Revenue.
