- Initiated research and outreach in 2021 in response to historic investments
- Interested in supporting a cohesive, coordinated statewide strategy and approach to federal funding readiness for built and natural infrastructure investments
- Support for Governor's office
  - Desire to be nimble and responsive
  - Focusing on near-term deadlines and agency readiness

Increasing sense of urgency

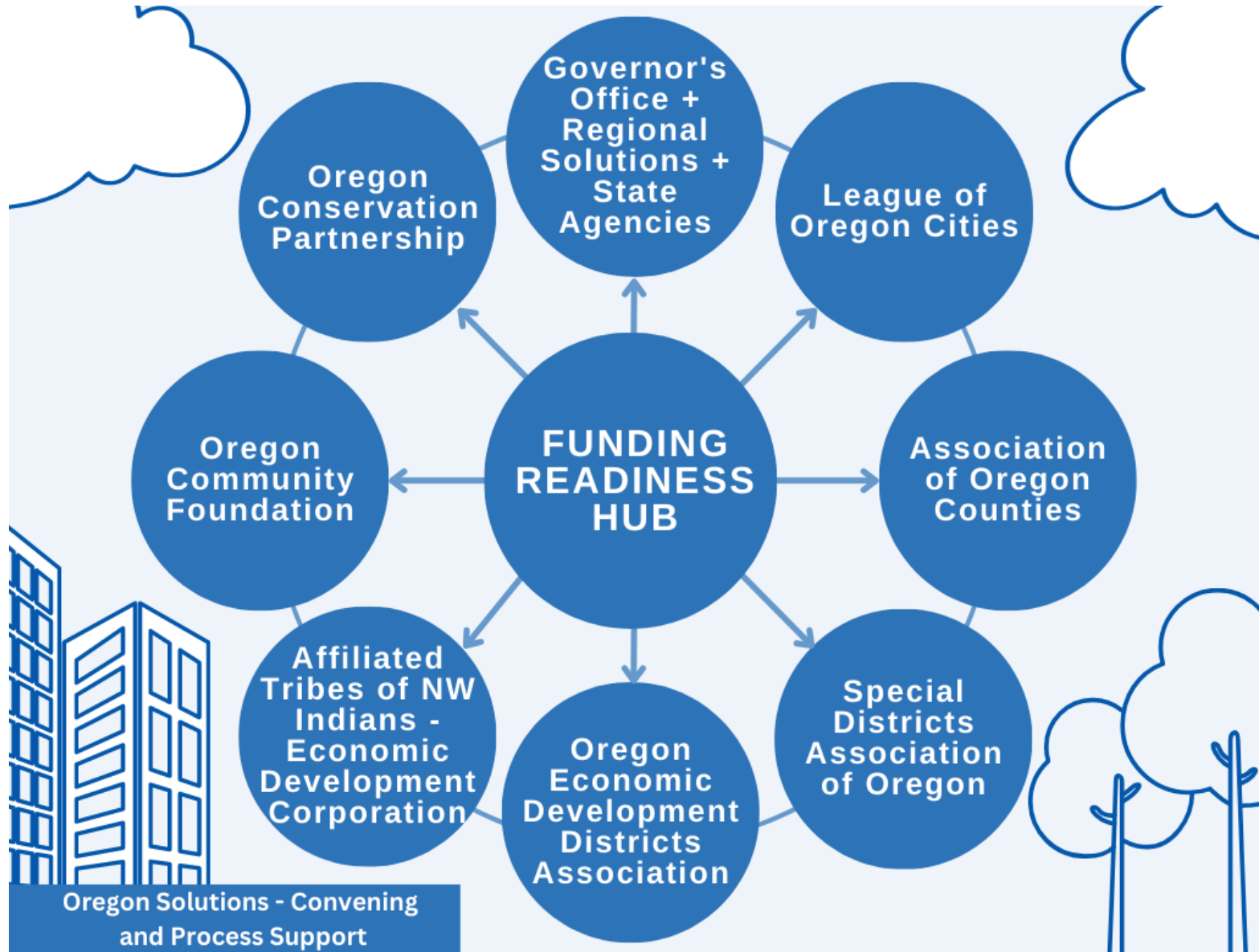
Once in a generation opportunity
