

SB 104 -3 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Department of Human Services to evaluate implementation of certification of agency with choice service providers and report to the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-3 Replaces the measure.

Modifies definition of ‘agency with choice services’. Directs the Department of Human Services (DHS) to contract with one or more organizations to deliver agency with choice services by July 1, 2024. Modifies requirements for organizations contracting with DHS. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

BACKGROUND:

An employer of record for direct support professionals who are providing in-home services and supports to an individual can provide certain agency with choice services: coordinating the schedules and responsibilities of direct support professionals who are providing in-home services and supports to the individual; for each direct support professional providing in-home services and supports to the individual, withholding, filing and paying income and employment-related taxes, including workers’ compensation premiums and unemployment taxes; verifying the qualifications of each direct support professional; and providing other administrative and employment-related supports. The Department of Human Service (DHS) can certify agencies to deliver agency with choice services as a community-based services option under ORS 427.007.

Senate Bill 104 requires Department of Human Services to evaluate implementation of certification of agency with choice service providers and report to the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.
