

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: HB 2500 - 6

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Measure Description:

Requires that mileage reimbursement be paid to home care workers, personal support workers and other direct support professionals who commute more than 25 miles each way to client's residence.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority, Department of Human Services

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure replaces the introduced version of the measure. The measure requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules to require mileage reimbursement at the state rate to individuals who provide home care services in remote locations, paid for by DHS.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
