**Measure Description:**

Requires landlord to allow dwelling to be used as family child care home.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Housing and Community Services Department, Department of Human Services, Department of Early Learning and Care

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure requires landlords to allow the use of a dwelling unit as a family child care home if the home is certified or registered with the Office of Child Care, the tenant has notified the landlord and the home does not violate zoning, an association’s governing documents, or Early Learning Council (ELC) rules.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
