Measure Description:

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study policies and practices governing the provision of and payments for health services in the medical assistance program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Senate Committee on Rules.

SB 492, with the -1 amendment, replaces the introduced version. The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is directed to study payments for health services provided in the medical assistance program and prescribes topics to be covered. OHA must report to the interim legislative committees related to health on or before September 15, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in Senate Committee on Rules.
