WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to study electronic liquor sales transaction reporting.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

HB 3265 directs the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC) to study electronic liquor sales transaction reporting. The OLCC shall study changing from a monthly reporting cycle to a quarterly reporting cycle. The OLCC will study the feasibility and cost for the OLCC as well as cost savings for a person or entity regulated resulting from the change. The OLCC must report the results to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to alcoholic beverage control no later than September 30, 2024.
