Measure Description:

Requires the Legislative Fiscal Officer to prepare a 10-year fiscal impact statement for each measure reported out of a legislative committee that could affect the ability of the state or health care entities to meet the target established under the Health Care Cost Growth Target Program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Legislative Revenue Office, Legislative Fiscal Office, Oregon Health Authority, Legislative Policy and Research Office

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure modifies provisions of the Health Care Cost Growth Target Program relating to compensation of frontline workers and the calculation of the health care cost growth target. The measure directs the Legislative Fiscal Officer, in collaboration with the Legislative Revenue Officer, Legislative Policy and Research Director, and state agencies, to prepare a 10-year fiscal impact statement for each measure reported out of committee that might affect the ability of the state or health care entities from meeting the health care cost growth target.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
