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Measure Description:

Establishes Aligning for Health Pilot Program, administered by Oregon Health Authority, to test alternative methods for payment for health care.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services, Oregon Health Authority

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Aligning for Health Pilot Program administered by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). The measure describes requirements for the first five years of the pilot program. OHA is required to report to the Legislative Assembly committees on health care after completion of the third phase. The measure is repealed January 2, 2034.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
