Measure Description:

Prohibits public bodies from seizing certain benefits and resources intended for persons in custody of Department of Human Services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, Department of Human Services, Department of Revenue, State Treasurer

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure prohibits public bodies from paying for services for an individual under 21 and in the care of Department of Human Services by seizing Social Security benefits, death benefits, survivor benefits, crime victim impact payments, inheritance proceeds, wages or other benefits or resources except child support payments.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Rules.
