#### New Narrative: Who We Are

New Narrative is a non-profit mental health agency in operation for over 45 years in the greater Portland area.

#### **Our Mission**

From clinical care and peer support programs to housing, we provide resources so people seeking mental health care can develop the tools to thrive, not just survive.

#### **Our Vision**

A future where everyone seeking mental health care can live the life they choose.

#### New Narrative: Who We Serve

- Over 3,000 adults served each year
- Typical backgrounds and conditions:
  - Homeless or formerly homeless approx 25-40%
  - Significant mental health challenges 100%
  - Low income and on OHP or County General Funds 100%
  - Justice involved (Psychiatric Security Review Board & County Corrections) 10-25%
  - Discharged from the state hospital 10%
  - Aging out of the foster care system 5%

#### New Narrative: What We Do

New Narrative provides a comprehensive set of services using *team-based care* to support the whole person:

- Mental health and psychiatric care
- Case management
- Skills training
- Peer support services
- Housing a full continuum: residential treatment, transitional, supported, and independent
- Housing services

Housing is a big part of our programming at New Narrative, because we believe <a href="housing is healthcare">housing is healthcare</a>.

### Mission-Based Property Management

- Why we brought property management in-house and based it on mission
- Commercial property managers
  - Not trained or trauma-informed in working with residents who experience significant mental health challenges
  - Not incented to collaborate with health providers in removing leasing barriers or resolving lease violations
  - Resulting in higher eviction rates
- The Key to removing leasing barriers and increasing housing retention

### Mission-Based Property Mgmt: Our Approach

- Cultural shift about how we partner
  - Vision of our staff
  - Relationships with our tenants and stakeholders
- Staff Training and approach to supporting complex and vulnerable populations
  - Trauma informed and professional trained in progressive paradigms
- Low Barrier commitment for PSH units
  - Designing low barrier pathways into housing; avoiding arbitrary goal posts

### Mission-Based Property Mgmt: Our Approach

- Mission based design of policy and procedures
  - Following the law, stewards of the properties, and promoting housing successes
- Early intervention in lease violations and conflict areas
  - Proactively addressing issues with tenants; not reacting to problems
- Integration with services and supports for tenants
  - Cultural and philosophical alignment
  - Close working relationships with all stakeholders
  - Open and transparent communications

Creating Thriving Communities – a home, not just four walls and a roof

### Mission-Based Property Mgmt: Our Outcomes

- Reduced Eviction rate: 6% over 6 years; recent PSH studies show up to
   23% return to houselessness over 2-year period
  - High chance that PSH evictions lead to homelessness and traumatization
- Reduced unit turnover rate and higher occupancy in housing units
- Reduced use of emergency services and healthcare
  - 75% less emergency room use\*
  - 80% less inpatient hospital use\*
- Higher engagement with supportive services and property management
- People meeting their goals and thriving in their communities
- Cost to system per person over 12 months
  - Houselessness Between \$40,000 \$100,000, depending on utilization\*
  - Permanent Supportive Housing \$28,000\*

### Mission-Based Property Mgmt: *The Future*

- Securing technical assistance funding
  - Expanding to support other affordable housing partners by providing missionbased property management in both traditional affordable and PSH units
  - Lending Technical Assistance to both affordable housing nonprofits, private landlords, and commercial property management companies
