All of the bills in today's public hearing do not comply with Article 4 Section 21 of the Oregon Constitution, Senate Rule 13.02, or ORS 171.134. These bills need to comply with these provisions before moving forward

<u>HB 3220 A</u>

- **Catchline/Summary:** Imposes new requirements on hospitals with respect to financial assistance policies and processes. Requires Oregon Health Authority to impose civil penalties for violation of requirements.

<u>HB 2817 A</u>

- **Catchline/Summary:** Clarifies area of leg to which definition of "podiatry" applies.

HB 2486

- **Catchline/Summary:** Allows certain pharmacy technicians to administer vaccines. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

HB 2278

- **Catchline/Summary:** Authorizes pharmacists to administer influenza vaccine to persons six months of age or older. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
