All of the bills in today's public hearing and work sessions do not comply with Article 4 section 21 of Oregon's Constitution, Senate Rule 13.02, or ORS 171.134. They need to comply with these provisions before moving forward.

Public Hearing

• <u>HB 2372</u> A

Requires Oregon Youth Authority to study issues related to youth. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary not later than September 15, 2024.] Modifies purpose and duties of Youth Development Council and Youth Development Division. Modifies requirements of local high-risk juvenile crime prevention plans. Flesh-Kincaid Grade Level: **14.2**

Flesch Reading Ease Score: 16.2

• <u>HB 2519 A</u>

Prohibits acceptance of consideration for displaying human remains to public. Creates exception in certain circumstances. Punishes violations by maximum of one year's imprisonment. Imposes civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 per day of violation.] Creates civil cause of action for estate of decedent whose remains are unlawfully displayed. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

o <u>HB 3443 A</u>

Prohibits landlords from terminating lease or taking other specified actions due to status of tenant as victim of bias crime. Flesh-Kincaid Grade Level: **13.5** Flesch Reading Ease Score: **34.3**

 - <u>HB 2405 A</u>

Requires that court dismissing charges involving orders of commitment due to defendant lacking fitness to proceed also order transport of defendant back to jurisdiction in which charges were initiated. Flesh-Kincaid Grade Level: **18.1** Flesch Reading Ease Score: **16.7**

o <u>HB 2593</u>

Reduces penalties for crime of offensive littering in certain circumstances. Punishes by maximum fine of \$1,000 when person discards or deposits, or permits to be thrown from person's vehicle, less than one cubic foot of rubbish, trash, garbage, debris or other refuse.
