The 2023-25 Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) recommended budget for the Oregon Board of Pharmacy is 23 positions (23.00 FTE), and \$10,783,382 Other Funds. This is an 11.3% increase from the 2021-23 legislatively approved budget. The recommended budget is projected to leave the board with an ending balance of \$3,475,802, equivalent to 7.7 months of operating funds.

The 2023-25 LFO recommended budget contains the following:

• Policy Option Package 101 - Expanding Workload Positions: Increase Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$386,599 to fund a Health Care Investigator position to assist with ongoing increases in inspection and investigative workload.

No revenue adjustments were made for new fees that were administratively approved, including Pharmacy Prescription Kiosks, Pharmacy Prescription Lockers, and Remote Dispensing Site Pharmacies, as the revenue impact is anticipated to be minimal.
