Project – Ashland ASLEP

- Project Cost \$5,373,235 (Bond Funds)
- Project Status In Solicitation for Construction
 - Renovate and upgrade existing armory
- Estimated Completion February 2025

Project – Corvallis ASLEP

- Project Cost \$4,317,605 Other Funds / \$3,500,000 Federal Funds
- Project Status In Solicitation for Construction
 Renovate and upgrade existing armory
- Estimated Completion February 2025

Project – Washington County Readiness Center

- Project Cost \$5,300,000 Other Funds / \$26,000,000 Federal Funds
- Project Status In Planning
 - Build new 81,584 sq ft readiness center
- Estimated Completion February 2026

Project – (4) RTC Barracks

- (4) Project Cost \$28,243,000 Federal Funds
 - Project Status (3) In Design/ (1) In Construction
 - Open bay barracks with 40 beds In Construction
 - RTI Barracks with up to 120 beds In Design
 - Officers Barracks with up to 120 beds In Design

2021-23 Capital Construction Update

Project – RTC Guard Shack

- Project Cost \$2,414,099 Federal Funds
- Project Status Phase 2 In Design
 - Secure entry to meet ATFP standards
 - Add guard shack and controlled entry point
- Estimated Completion Date August 2023
 - Phase 1 Completed September 2022

Project – RTC Firing Range

- Project Cost \$2,300,000 Federal Funds
- Project Status In Construction
 - Removing the existing pneumatic targeting system
 - Add new electrical/mechanical system
 - Install new target lifters and control system
- Estimated Completion Date December 2023

Project – Corvallis Parking

- Project Cost \$300,000 General Fund / \$900,000 Federal Funds
- Project status In Construction
 - Repair and expand existing parking lot
 - Replace compound fencing
- Estimated Completion Date October 2023



Policy Package 490 Owen Summers

Project Cost:

- \$2,909,970 Other Funds (Q-Bonds)
 - Subject to Modification
- Additional to \$5.8M Q-Bonds approved in 2019.

Project Timeline:

- Start Date 3/1/2024
- End Date 2/28/2027

Project Scope

- Built 1988
- Metal roof repair
- Exterior clean & seal of brick & metal siding
- Repair soffit, fascia, gutters & downspouts
- Clean, seal & restripe parking lot

Project Impact

- Complete many of the deferred maintenance projects that will restore building to like new condition.
- Units Impacted; Joint Forces Headquarters, Primary ARNG Staff



Policy Package 491 Newport Armory

Project Cost:

- \$5,327,482 Other Funds (Q-Bonds)
- Armory Service Life Extension
- Currently undergoing a Regional Emergency Enhancement project for seismic resiliency

Project Timeline:

- Start Date 3/1/2025
- End Date 2/28/2028

Project Scope:

- Built 1962
- Replace outdated, inefficient or defective building systems
- Remodel classrooms, admin space, latrines, kitchen and assembly hall
- Repair/Replace paving, site lighting, landscaping & fencing

Project Impact:

- Increases facility resiliency which enables its ability to support emergency response to the community.
- Units Impacted; ARNG Engineer Unit



Policy Package 492 McMinnville Armory

Project Cost

- \$6,329,665 Other Funds (Q-Bonds)
- Armory Service Life Extension and Regional Emergency Enhancement project for seismic resiliency

Project Timeline:

- Start Date 3/1/2024
- End Date 2/28/2027

Project Scope

- Built 1978
- Replace outdated, inefficient or defective building systems
- Remodel classrooms, admin space, latrines, kitchen and assembly hall
- Seismic structural improvements & upgrades including new generator

Project Impact

- Increases facility resiliency which enables its ability to support emergency response to the community.
- Units Impacted; ARNG Artillery Unit
