Measure Description:

Exempts from labeling requirements drug intended to reverse opioid overdose when drug is dispensed by physician or physician assistant. Exempts rules adopted by the Oregon State Board of Nursing from applying to an opioid reversal drug approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration if the drug is a nasal spray dispensed by a nurse practitioner at their location of practice.

Analysis:
