- Slow the Spread Program







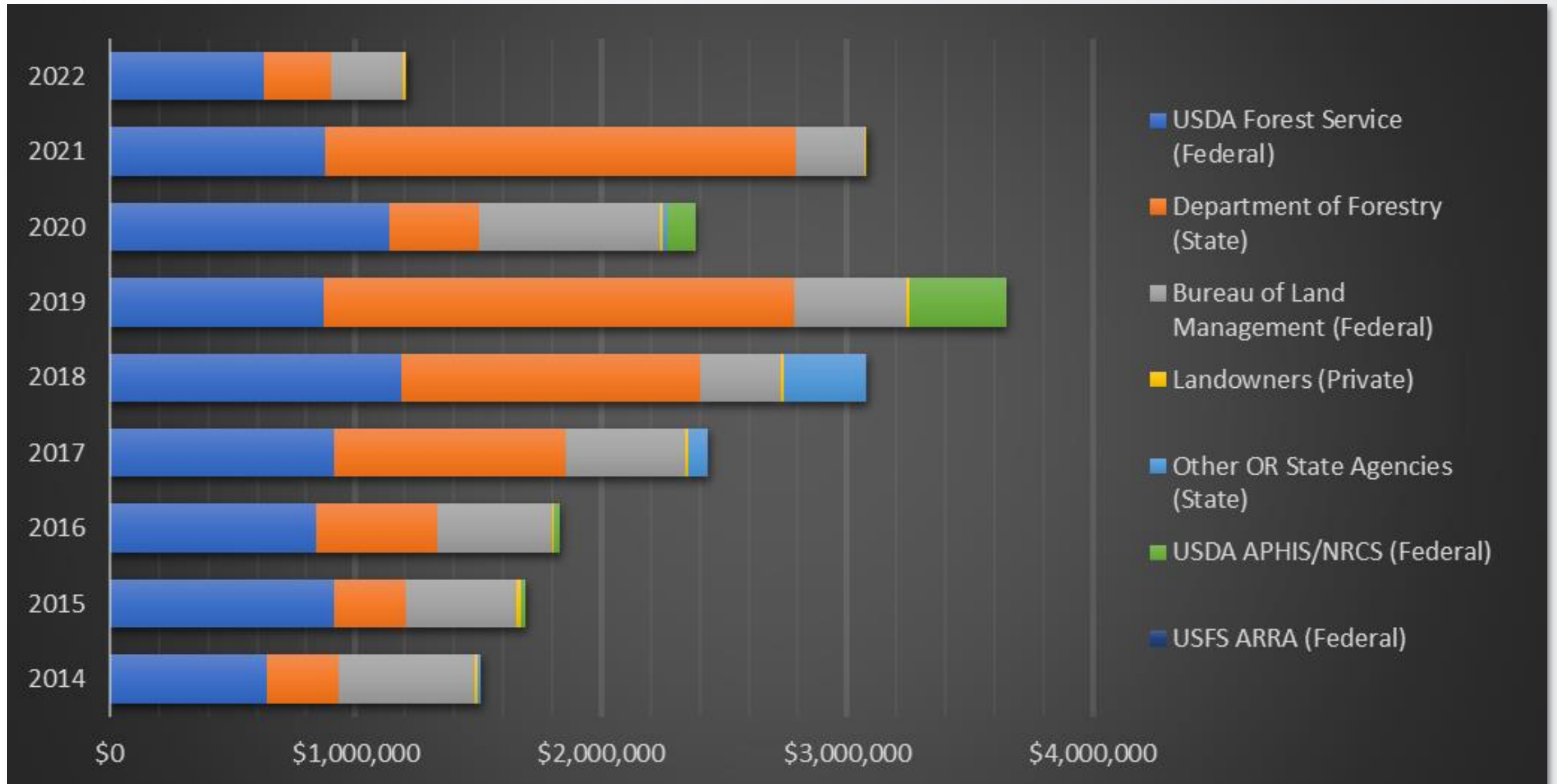
# Slow the Spread Program
