

## **SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

### **SB 5531 Psychiatric Security Review Board**

SB 5531 is the budget bill for the Psychiatric Security Review Board.

The Psychiatric Security Review Board, or PSRB, protects the public by ensuring people who have a psychiatric illness and/or intellectual disability and have been placed under the Board's jurisdiction as a result of committing a crime receive the necessary support to reduce the risk of future dangerous behavior. The Board's predominant body of work involves its statutory jurisdiction over people who have committed a crime and are found by a court to be guilty except for insanity and includes overseeing treatment outcomes for those committed to the Oregon State Hospital, coordinating treatment for clients who are conditionally released from the State Hospital and receive services in the community, revoking conditional release as appropriate, and discharging clients from the Board's jurisdiction.

The Human Services Subcommittee approved a budget of \$4,536,912 General Fund, and 13 positions. Budget increases are due to \$118,500 as PSRB moves its IT support under the Department of Administrative Services and \$219,679 for a position to assist the agency in onsite IT support and migrating from unsupported legacy systems to those supported by the State.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 5531 be amended by the –1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
