

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2013 Relating to alcohol

HB 2013 permits malt beverages, wine, and cider products to be directly delivered to a retailer in Oregon who holds a direct shipper permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission. The measure brings statute into conformity with a legal settlement reached between OLCC and out of state beverage distributors.

The -A4 amendment provides \$175,000 Other Funds expenditure limitation to the OLCC to modify its existing IT system to capture the filing of reports on the quantity of beverages shipped, and contains technical conforming statutory reference recommended by Legislative Counsel.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends HB 2013 be amended by the -A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
