Re: Sudden Oak Death Report Follow Up

The Department joined the committee on May 11<sup>th</sup> to present an overview of our [Sudden Oak Death \(SOD\) report](#). Co-Chair Dembrow asked for breakdown of the land types that have received SOD treatment thus far.

As of May 11, 2023 a total of 8,445 acres have received SOD treatments. Of those, 6,310 acres, about 75%, have been on private lands while 2,135 acres, about 25% have been on federal public lands.

Representative Holvey also inquired about a direct link to ODF's Economic Impact Assessment of Sudden Oak Death. That assessment can be found [here](#).
