Smoke Management Program Goals

ODF and DEQ partnership

- (a) Minimize smoke emissions resulting from prescribed burning;
- (b) Provide maximum opportunity for essential forestland burning;
- (c) Protect public health by avoiding intrusions;
- (d) Comply with state and federal air quality.



CAA Requirements - NAAQS

National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS)

Directives and Rules = State Implementation Plan

PM 2.5 NAAQS update expected in 2024



5-year Review

Program reviews rules with SMAC every 5-years

Last review

- Updated definition of intrusion
- Created Community Response Plan
- Required after-action meetings for intrusions that exceed NAAQS

Promoted emission reductions from covered piles



Steps for Next 5-Year Review

- Currently reviewing 2019 rule changes
- Formal rulemaking process to begin late fall 2023, early spring 2024
 - Includes coordination with BOF, EQC, SMAC
- Planned public meetings in communities throughout Oregon
