

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2100

Relating to transportation funding

House Bill 2100 raises various fees for the issuance of identification cards, vehicle inspections, vehicle registration fees, trailers, campers, motor homes, driver licenses, replacement of registration plates, driver testing, and license reinstatement.

The proposed fee increases align more closely with the costs to provide various services by the Department of Transportation's Driver and Motor Vehicle Services division. The measure is projected to generate an additional \$18.0 million in state highway revenue resources, and the fee revenue is recognized in HB 5040, the Department of Transportation's budget bill. The bill has a minimal fiscal impact to the agency to implement.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends House Bill 2100 be reported out do pass.
