**Subject:** HB 2048 – Relating to behavior analysis interventionists

**Work Session Recommendations** 

HB 2048 directs the Health Licensing Office (HLO) within the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to issue provisional registration to applicants for behavior analysis interventionist. This includes the adoption of rules to establish a process for issuing provisional registration and clarifies timelines under which provisional registration must be issued.

The -A5 amendment removes the requirement for HLO to contract with a third party to study access to behavior analysis interventionists. The -A5 amendment results in a Minimal Fiscal Impact for the bill.

## **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment.

MOTION: I move adoption of the -A5 amendment to HB 2048. (VOTE)

## **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that HB 2048, as amended by the -A5 amendment, be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
