On May 30th, the Human Services Subcommittee recommended approval of the submission of a federal grant application from the Oregon Health Authority to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for the Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnership for Success for States program in the amount of \$6.25 million over 5 years.

This grant program aims to help reduce the onset and progression of substance misuse and its related problems by supporting the development and delivery of state and community substance misuse and prevention, and mental health promotion services. The grant funds would be used to strengthen Oregon's capacity to identify and address substance use prevention concerns, such as underage drinking, marijuana, tobacco, electronic cigarettes, opioids, methamphetamine, and heroin use.

If awarded, the grant is for five years at up to \$1.25 million per year with the first award anticipated on September 30, 2023. The grant requires 2 half-time positions for a total of 1.00 FTE and requires no state match.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends approval.
