

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1050

Relating to the implementation of new academic content standards

SB 1050 extends the implementation date for content standards related to Holocaust and genocide studies by one year, to align with the implementation of ethnic studies content standards in the 2026-2027 school year. The measure requires the Department of Education to provide professional development to teachers on the new content standards.

The Education Subcommittee recommended adoption of the -1 amendment, which adds \$2,767,466 General Fund and one position (0.88 FTE) to develop content and facilitate statewide professional development for teachers and administrators on the new content standards for Holocaust and genocide studies and ethnic studies.

The Education Subcommittee recommends SB 1050 be amended by the –1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
